

2010 - 50th Anniversary Celebrations

As many of you are aware, 2010 is the Society's 50th anniversary year. We have a number of events planned over the year to mark this achievement, which in addition to being a celebration for our members, are designed to involve the local community more in our activities. The intention of these events is to raise the profile of the Society and potentially generate even more new members. A summary of the various events is listed below.

- Exhibition of the members work at the Kirkleatham Pavilion 27 February to 25 April. This exhibition will then be on display at various venues in Saltburn throughout the year.
- Digital Photography workshops for the community. Alan Meek, Peter Appleton and myself have developed four modules each of two hours duration covering the basics of digital photography which we will offering to the local community in April/May. This material is also being delivered to a small group of pupils and teachers at Huntcliff school during November/December this year to assist them with the school project (see below).
- A photographic project with a small group of pupils from Huntcliff school. This is currently ongoing and we hope to include a portfolio of their work in the exhibition.
- Community photography competition based on summer activities. We intend to use our website for submissions in addition to postal and a drop-off point.
- Cleveland Concert Band and photographic exhibition in Saltburn Methodist Church on 19th June.
- Celebrity Photographer presentation at Huntcliff School in Autumn 2010. Details TBA.
- A presentation of a selection of work by the North Yorks & South Durham Digital Audio Visual Group at Huntcliff School in Autumn 2010, date TBA.
- The development of a DVD showing the history of the development of our society.

Publicity for these events will commence early in the new year, so if any of our members would like to lend a hand in supporting any of these activities, just let any of the Committee members know, your help would be very much appreciated.
